Flash Point BASE 36 °C, CURING AGENT 36 °C, ADDITIVE 4 °C

Surface Preparation All surfaces to be coated should be clean, dry and free from

contamination.

High pressure fresh water wash and remove all oil / grease,

soluble contaminants and other foreign matters. See "Painting Specification" for the details.
